

SECTION 5 - MILEAGE

C. LOCALITY MILEAGE

1. Definitions

Locality mileage is the mileage applicable to a central office line of a subscriber located outside the base rate area but within the central office district of exchanges that have locality rates. There is no charge for locality mileage. The territory outside the base rate area is divided into localities as follows: (C)

<u>Approximate Distance From Base Rate Area Boundary</u>	<u>Locality</u>
Up to 1 Mile	A
1 to 2 Miles	B
Over 2 Miles	C

<u>Clymer Exchange Approximate Distance From Base Rate Area Boundary</u>	<u>Locality</u>
Up to 2 Miles	A
2 to 4 Miles	B
Over 4 Miles	C

In exchanges having locality rates, as specified in Section 10, the locality mileage rates shown in 2 below apply in addition to the basic monthly rates
