

### 3. **REGULATIONS**

The regulations and rates specified herein are in addition to the applicable regulations found in other sections of this Tariff.

### 4. **AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE**

- 4.1 TSP System service is available to all qualified Federal Government Agency customers. Non-Federal Government customers requesting TSP System service must be sponsored by a qualified Federal Government Agency. The request for a TSP Authorization Code must be processed through the sponsoring Agency.

TSP System service is applicable to any service for which the associated tariff authorizes TSP System service. These services include General Exchange Service, Local Exchange Service, Wide Area Telecommunications Service, Cellular Mobile Telephone Interconnection Service, Private Line Service, Digital Link Service, Dataphone Digital Service, Switched Access Service and Special Access Service.

### 5. **PROVISION OF SERVICE**

- 5.1 Priority installation and/or restoration of NSEP telecommunications services shall be provided in accordance with Part 64, Appendix A., of the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) Rules and Regulations. Any change to or reissuance of these manual supersede tariff language contained herein.
- 5.2 In addition, TSP System service shall be provided in accordance with the guidelines set forth in "Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) System for National Security Emergency Preparedness (NSEP) Service Vendor Handbook" National Communications System (NCS) Handbook 3-2-1 and in "Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) System for National Security Emergency Preparedness (NSEP) Service User Manual" NCS Manual 3-1-1.
