GENERAL INFORMATION

Water for Building Purposes

- A. If an application is made for the supply of water for building or construction purposes, the Company shall have the option of providing metered or unmetered service. Water for building or construction purposes will be furnished upon application for metered service through a service pipe connection to the main, and the Customer will be liable for the amount of water used in accordance with Service Classification No. 2.
- B. If the Applicant desires metered service, he shall deposit with the Company the cost of the meter and shall keep the said meter safe and accessible during its use.
- C. If unmetered water service is applied for, the building rate shall be paid in advance.

5.7 Private Fire Service

- A. Customers desiring service connections of reasonable size to the mains of the Company, for private fire protection on their premises, shall make separate application for such service in writing. Such installation shall be in accordance with this Schedule, particularly the rules regarding the installation of service pipes, connecting pipes and facilities. Such service lines shall be used exclusively for fire protection purposes.
- B. All private fire service lines are equipped with meters or detectors. A flat rate is charged for this service, based upon the size of the meter or detector used, in accordance with Service Classification No. 3. No charge, however, is made for water used solely for fire extinguishing purposes, or for permitted testing purposes not in excess of 400 cubic feet per month. If water used for such purposes is billed, the Customer shall be entitled to a refund upon notifying the Company of any payment made for water used solely for such purposes. Water used for any other purpose, however, shall be billed at the consumption charges on Service Classification No. 1, 6 or 7 depending on the Customer's service classification.
