

GENERAL INFORMATION - Continued

The weather normalization adjustment will only take effect if the degree day variance from normal weather (NHDD – AHDD) exceeds 2.2% of normal (NHDD). For billing purposes, this adjustment will be made only for those billing periods with degree day variances that exceed 2.2% of normal (NHDD). The weather adjustment is made by adding to or subtracting the weather normalization adjustment for the billing period. The degree day variance will only reflect the difference between the actual weather and the 2.2% deadband.
