## 33.5 Filing of Main Extension Agreements

All main extensions shall require a main extension agreement setting forth the terms and conditions under which the extension will be made duly signed by the Company and applicant. No charges or conditions shall be obtained from or imposed upon the applicant for the provision and extension of water service, other than those contained in the main extension agreement in compliance with the Company's tariff or as approved by the Commission. One copy of each main extension agreement shall be filed with the Commission 30 days of execution; or where such agreements exceed ten in number in any calendar year, the Company may instead maintain a file at its offices of such agreements and file a summary of such agreements by January 31 of the following year.

## 33.6 <u>Installation and Maintenance of Service Line Beyond Highway Limits</u>

That portion of the service pipe without the limits of a street, avenue road or way as hereinbefore defined or easement area shall be provided, placed, constructed and maintained by the property owner or the customer but in accordance with such reasonable specification for the construction and maintenance thereof as may be filed in the tariff schedules of the Company.

## 33.7 Service Line Provided for Future Service

Whenever, at the request of an owner or occupant, a service pipe is provided by the Company thought which service is not immediately desired, said property owner or occupant shall bear the entire reasonable expense of providing, placing and constructing the service pipe and accessories, including any applicable taxes, but said owner or occupant shall be entitled to a refund whenever water service is begun for such part of the expense as the Company is hereinbefore required to assume. Such refund shall be the cost of said service pipe and accessories, less depreciation at the rate of three per cent annum for the period which said pipe has been in the ground.
