3.5 Penalty

If the Company fails to provide service to an applicant within the time required by this Section, the Company must pay to the applicant \$25.00 per day for each day or portion of a day that service is not supplied, unless the Commission or its designee determines that the utility had good cause for not providing service within the required time.

4. APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE FROM FIRE HYDRANTS:

- (a) Water for construction purposes for Federal, State, County or Municipal improvements may be furnished on an application for a metered service connection from a fire hydrant provided such application has first been approved by the Fire Chief of the municipality.
- (b) The applicant shall provide a suitable box for the protection of the meter and shall remove the meter and connection and close the fire hydrant at the end of work each day and shall promptly notify the Company when the service is to be discontinued. A charge of \$7.00 shall be made for the installation and removal of the metered connection.
- (c) In all cases where water is to be used for construction or other temporary purposes the applicant shall, in addition to paying any established charge for such connection, make a cash deposit with the Company in the amount of \$50.00, to cover any damage that may be done to the hydrant, meter or any other property of the Company, which deposit shall be returned to the applicant without interest upon the satisfactory discontinuance of service. The Company may also require an additional deposit to guarantee the payment of the charges for water service.
