BILLING QUANTITY:

The amount of gas to be billed each month under this Service Classification by the Company to the customer will be the amount consumed by the customer during any given calendar month.

All Customers, as described above:

SYSTEM BENEFITS CHARGE:

In addition to the above delivery service charges, all customers taking service under this service classification shall be subject to a System Benefits Charge as explained in General Information Rule No. 31.

STATEMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RATES:

All surcharges or refunds applicable to billings for Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 5, 7, and 8 will be duly filed with the Public Service Commission apart from this rate schedule, not less than three (3) days prior to the first of each month. Such statement will be available to the public at the Company's offices at which application for service may be made.

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES:

The rates and charges under this Service Classification will be increased by a tax factor pursuant to Rule 19.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due and payable. Full payment must be received on or before the due date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%).

TERM:

One year initially and renewable on a year-to-year basis thereafter until canceled on a prior thirty-day written notice by Company or customer.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO FIRM TRANSPORTATION SERVICE:

1. Written application upon the Company's prescribed forms is required.
2. Applications for service will be accepted in instances where extension of distribution main facilities for service requested would be required subject to Rule 10 of this schedule.
3. Firm transportation service will be provided only when and to the extent that the Company in its sole judgment has sufficient capacity available.
