## F. Changing Electricity Supply Pricing Options (Cont'd):

A customer taking service at the EOSA is not eligible to switch to the VPO or the EPO during any one-year Commodity Rate Period.

#### (c) Customer on the Variable Price Option (VPO):

A customer taking service at the VPO, either by choice or by default, can switch to the EPO.

A customer taking service at the VPO is not eligible to switch to the FPO or the EOSA during any one-year Commodity Rate Period.

# (d) Customer on the RG&E Fixed Price Option (FPO):

Effective through December 31, 2008:

A customer taking service on the FPO option can switch to the EOSA. The FPO may be adjusted each April 1, however, a customer on the FPO prior to April 1, who elects retail access, will not receive an April 1 FPO rate adjustment. A customer taking service at the FPO is not eligible to switch to the VPO or the EPO during any one-year Commodity Rate Period.

Effective beginning January 1, 2009:

A customer taking service on the FPO option can switch to the EOSA. A customer taking service at the FPO is not eligible to switch to the VPO or the EPO during any one-year Commodity Rate Period.

# 2. Process for Changing to a Retail Access Electricity Supply Pricing Option, January 1, 2005 and thereafter:

To effectuate the retail access enrollment, the customer's ESCO must contact RG&E to submit the customer's Retail Access enrollment information. A customer that participates in Retail Access may switch from one ESCO to another, but must maintain the same Electricity Supply Pricing Option (either the EPO or the EOSA) during any one-year Commodity Rate Period.

A VPO customer for whom RG&E receives an ESCO's retail access enrollment request will be enrolled in the EPO.

An FPO customer for whom RG&E receives a retail access enrollment request will be enrolled in the EOSA.

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
