NYSEG will provide Delivery and Commodity Service for the two Non-Retail Access choices.

3. NYSEG Fixed Price Option (FPO)

This Non-Retail Access choice includes a monthly operation and maintenance charge for luminaires and other facilities, fixed charges for NYSEG delivery service, a fixed Transition Charge (Non-Bypassable Charge [NBC]), and fixed commodity and merchant function charges for electricity supplied by NYSEG.

Kilowatt-hour use will be determined in accordance with General Information Section 2, Determination of Demand and Energy Use.
