

- (D) Unless otherwise set forth in this Tariff, the Company will not be responsible for the installation, operation, or maintenance of any CPE. Any CPE attached to the Company's Network shall be in conformance with all FCC requirements, rules and regulations. Where such equipment is connected to the facilities furnished pursuant to this Tariff, the responsibility of the Company shall be limited to the furnishing of facilities offered under this Tariff and to the maintenance and operation of such facilities. Beyond this responsibility, the Company shall not be responsible for:
1. The transmission of signals by Customer-provided equipment or for the quality of, or defects in, such transmission; or
 2. The reception of signals by Customer-provided equipment; or
 3. Network control signaling where such signaling is performed by Customer-provided network control signaling equipment; or
 4. The electric power consumed by CPE which shall be provided by, and maintained at the expense of, the Customer; or
 5. For ensuring that CPE connected to Company equipment and facilities is compatible with such equipment and facilities (the Customer is responsible for ensuring such compatibility).
