<u>Service Order</u>: The request for facilities or Service by an Applicant or Customer. See also ASR.

<u>Signaling System 7 ("SS7")</u>: The common channel out of band signaling protocol developed by the Consultative Committee for International Telephone and Telegraph (CCITT) and the American National Standards Institute (ANSI).

<u>Signaling Transfer Point Access</u>: Allows the Customer to access a specialized switch which provides SS7 network access and performs SS7 messaging, routing and screening.

<u>Switched Access</u>: Access to or from the switched network of a LEC for the purpose of originating or terminating communications.

Station: Telephone equipment from or to which calls are placed.

<u>Telecommunications Relay Service ("TRS")</u>: Enables deaf, hard-of-hearing or speech-impaired persons who use a text telephone or similar device to communicate freely with the hearing population not using text telephone and vice versa.

<u>Termination of Service</u>: Discontinuance of both incoming and outgoing Service.

<u>Trunk</u>: A communications path, connecting two switching systems, used in the establishment of an end-to-end connection.
