

Presubscription: An arrangement whereby an End User may select and designate to the Company an IXC it wishes to access, without an Access Code, for completing interLATA toll calls and/or intraLATA toll calls. The End User may select one IXC for completing interLATA toll calls and another for completing intraLATA toll calls, or may select the same IXC to complete both. The selected IXC(s) are referred to as the End User's Primary Interexchange Carrier ("PIC") for interLATA toll, and as the End User's intraLATA Primary Interexchange Carrier ("LPIC") for intraLATA toll. The End User may select any IXC that orders Feature Group D Switched Access at the Local Switching Center that serves the End User.

Rate Center: Denotes a geographically specified point used to determine distance dependent rates.

Recurring Charges: Charges that are assessed for Services included within this Tariff on a recurring, monthly basis.

Service: The telecommunications Services offered by the Company.

Service Commencement Date: The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested Service or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept Service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or this Tariff, in which case the Service Commencement Date is the date of the Customer's acceptance of Service. The parties may mutually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date. If the Company does not have an executed Service Order from a Customer, the Service Commencement Date will be the first date on which the Service or facility was used by the Customer.

Service Connection Charge: A one-time charge which applies for Company work associated with activities to set up/change accounts, including, but not limited to, Service Order issuance, programming, billing, etc., for installations, moves, changes, or rearrangements of Services and/or equipment.
