## (F) <u>Termination Liability</u>

In the event that a(n) (1) Primary Rate Interface or Port, or (2) Inbound Interface or Port, is disconnected after Service has been established, but prior to expiration of the service term, the Customer will be required to pay a Termination Charge. This charge is calculated as follows:

- -the number of net disconnected interfaces or ports; multiplied by
- -the total monthly rate for the net disconnected PRI interfaces or ports; multiplied by
- -the number of months remaining on the Customer's service term; multiplied by
- -fifty percent (50%)

A Termination Charge will not apply; (1) when the Customer moves the point of termination within the same Customer Premises, or (2) to a new location, provided the existing TPP is continued or extended.

## (G) <u>Cancellation Charge</u>

When a Customer cancels an order, a Cancellation Charge will apply as specified in Section 2.9 of this tariff. A Cancellation Charge will not apply:

- 1. When a Customer cancels an order for the disconnection of existing ISDN Primary Rate Interface.
- 2. If the Company or the Customer misses a service installation date by more than thirty (30) days due to a Force Majeure condition, the Customer may cancel an order without incurring a Cancellation Charge.
