- (C) In addition, Applicants are eligible for discounted Lifeline rates when approved to receive either a Veterans Disability Pension or a Veterans Surviving Spouse Pension. Applicants must provide proof to the Company that they are receiving one of these pensions.
- (D) Lifeline Service is effective upon receipt of a completed and signed form or an application form certified from an entity authorized by the Company. If the form is not returned, no further action is taken by the Company to establish eligibility. The Lifeline discount is credited as of the Service Start Date.
- (E) An individual's eligibility may be documented by information obtained by the Company as a result of enrollment programs, including, but not limited to, confidential computerized matching programs, conducted by the Company in conjunction with the New York State Department of Social Services ("DSS") and/or the New York City Community Development Agency ("CDA").
- (F) The Company will, upon learning from DSS and/or CDA that a Customer is eligible for Lifeline, but is not currently enrolled in the program, and after providing a period of 30 days from the date the Customer was notified of eligibility for the program for the Customer to decline enrollment, convert the Customer's Service to Lifeline reduced rate Service without a signed application. The Lifeline Service is effective as of the date 30 days from the date of the notice.
