GENERAL INFORMATION (Cont'd)

II. 20.f CONTINUED

(1) Company's Right to Curtail or Limit Service

In the event the Company reasonably foresees an inability to meet the firm daily requirements of core sales or transportation Customers, the Company shall have the right to curtail or limit any Customer's use of gas. The Company shall not incur any liability for any cost, expense, loss or injury which may be sustained by reason of such curtailment or limitation, except as described below.

The Company will provide notice of curtailment by telephone, broadcast media or otherwise according to need. If a Customer has been directed to curtail consumption, by telephone or otherwise, and refuses to comply with the directed reductions, the Company may in its discretion charge an additional \$25.00 per Mcf for such unauthorized usage.

Upon the request of the Company, each Supplier serving transportation Customers on the Company's system shall provide to the Company a plan for curtailment of its Customers.

During a period of curtailment, Suppliers shall be required to maintain city gate deliveries of gas at the direction of the Company, subject to qualified upstream force majeure interruptions or curtailment preventing Suppliers' ability to secure and deliver such supplies. The Company will calculate Suppliers' Daily Delivery Quantities and Aggregate Daily Delivery Quantities according to the applicable procedures. Such delivery requirements shall apply whether Suppliers' customer(s) are curtailed or not. In the event of a redirection of supplies under this provision, the entity whose gas was taken in such instances shall be compensated under the schedule and in the same manner set forth in Section II.20.f.(5), Short Term Curtailment.

The cost of supplies purchased by the Company for the purposes hereunder shall be recovered as a gas cost under General Information Section 19.
