 - (3) In the event the application of the Mitigation Rate to any SC-13T customer's bill results in a negative total NYSEG gas bill, the Mitigation Rate (and associated Mitigation Deferral) will be adjusted to result in a zero amount due on the bill.
 - (4) Beginning the first month after completion of the phase-in, a surcharge equal to the Mitigation Adjustment will be applied to the TS line item of SC-01S and SC-13T customers' bills.
 - (5) The applicable therms for this option are those associated with SC-01S and SC-13T.
