GENERAL INFORMATION

22. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RIDER FOR S.C. 2 SMALL GENERAL SERVICE, S.C. 3 LARGE GENERAL SERVICE, S.C. 5 FIRM TRANSPORTATION SERVICE, AND S.C. 8 GAS TRANSPORTATION SERVICE WITH STANDBY SALES SERVICE:

- 22.1 Any applicant or customer who qualifies to take service under the above referenced service classes and:
- 22.1.1 Who increases its gas use by:
 - S.C. 2: 280 Therms per month
 - S.C. 3: The lesser of twenty-five (25) percent or 7,200 therms per month
 - S.C. 5: 250,000 Therms of annual transportation volumes
 - S.C. 8: 250,000 Therms of annual transportation volumes or sales volumes under S.C. No. 8
 - 22.1.2 Whose increase in gas use was a result of: a) constructing a new facility; or (b) purchasing or leasing an existing facility that has been vacant for at least six months; or (c) expanding an existing facility and;
 - 22.1.3 Whose facilities are classified by the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (1972 edition or supplements thereto) as Manufacturing (Division D), Transportation-Communication (Division E), Wholesale Trade (Division F), Finance, Insurance, Real Estate (Division H - applicable to real estate offices or facilities, not to real estate ventures such as apartment buildings, motels, hotels, etc.), Business Services (Major Group 73 of Division I); and
 - 22.1.4 Who applied for service hereunder not less than 60 days prior to the commencement of the construction of such new facility or prior to a commitment to the purchase or lease of such existing facility;
 - 22.1.4.1 Shall be eligible to take service hereunder and in accordance with the provisions of the applicable Service Classification and to pay a reduced amount for such service as described below. Service supplied hereunder shall not be used to supply any of the customer's existing facilities. Service must commence within 90 days of the agreed upon start-up date of the new facility.
