APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

All purposes except as otherwise provided in Service Classification No. 1. Available in all territory served when Company has facilities suitable and adequate for the load.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Continuous, except as provided in Rule 3 of Rules and Regulations. Natural gas or a mixture of natural gas and other gas of not less than 1000 British Thermal Units per cubic foot. Normal pressure 6 inches, but not less than 4 inches, water column.

DEFINITIONS:

<u>Monthly Capacity Gas Supply Charge</u> – the rate per therm reflecting fixed charges provided for in 16 NYCRR 720-6.5, as included in the Monthly Cost of Gas Rate.

<u>Ratchet Usage</u> – equals one-third of the highest monthly usage taken by the customer during any monthly billing period in the previous months of January through March inclusive.

<u>Metered Usage</u> – is equal to the CCF associated with the customer's monthly billing (25-35 days) multiplied by the applicable BTU conversion factor.

Billed Usage – the higher of Metered Usage or Ratcheted Usage as defined above.

MONTHLY RATES:

MONTHLY COST OF GAS:
