## N. <u>SUPPLIER-INITIATED SUSPENSION OF SERVICE</u> (Cont'd)

All notices provided by the Supplier in connection with such termination shall be pursuant to Section 32 of Public Service Law as the same may be revised, modified, amended, clarified, supplemented, or superseded.

Fee for RG&E to calculate the amount customer would have paid if the entire utility service had been obtained from RG&E:

At the request of the Supplier, RG&E will calculate the amount the customer would have been billed by RG&E for commodity and delivery service if RG&E had been providing both services. The Supplier will provide RG&E with the specific billing period dates for which the calculation is to be performed. The fee for each calculation request, per account, will be \$2.55.

RG&E will implement Supplier-initiated suspensions within the same schedule as RG&E's suspensions, to the extent reasonably possible. If suspension cannot be timely implemented, RG&E will notify the Supplier of the delay and request that the Supplier issue a subsequent suspension notice to the customer, if necessary, and RG&E will take all reasonable actions to effectuate suspension as soon as possible.
