SCHEDULE A

GAS SERVICE-POINT DISTRIBUTION SERVICE

AVAILABLE:

In all of the Gas Control Area served by the Distribution Provider.

APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Any Distribution Customer supplying gas service to Retail Customers within the Distribution Provider's Gas Control Area, and any Direct Customer. To receive service under this Schedule A, the Distribution Customer or Direct Customer must abide by all Distribution Provider Tariff provisions, the Distribution Operating Agreement, and all other applicable laws, rules and provisions.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Distribution service of Distribution Customer-owned, pipeline quality, odorized gas on a firm basis from a delivery point within the Distribution Provider's Control Area to facilities at the Retail Customer's metering point. Distribution Customer-owned gas will be natural gas of not less that 1,000 Btu per cubic foot, supplied at pressures within the limits prescribed by the Public Service Commission.

OBLIGATION TO SERVE

It shall be the Distribution Provider's obligation to deliver the Distribution Customer's gas from the Distribution Point(s) of Receipt to the Distribution Point(s) of Delivery. However, the Distribution Provider shall have no obligation or responsibility for making arrangements for the Distribution Customer's supply of gas from the Distribution Customer's supply source to the Distribution Point(s) of Receipt.

MONTHLY RATE FOR DISTRIBUTION SERVICE:

The Distribution Customer will be billed the applicable charges associated with each of its Retail Customers' service point(s). Each service point is assigned a Service Classification based on the characteristics of service at each service point, as defined in the Special Provisions, below.

For each service point, the monthly rate shall consist of the minimum charge, service-point distribution charges, including the Distribution Rate Adjustment, and applicable taxes. See Appendix C for the applicable minimum and service-point distribution charges. The Distribution Rate Adjustment applicable to each Service Classification is defined in Special Provisions A.4, B.7 and C.3, below.

MINIMUM CHARGE

For each service point, see Appendix A for the minimum charge, exclusive of distribution rate adjustment charges, applicable to each Service Classification.

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES

The rates and charges under this Schedule, including any minimum charge, are increased by the applicable effective aggregate percentage shown in Rule 5.F for service supplied within the municipality where the Retail Customer is taking service.
