C. Service Classification No. 5 - Small General Service (Cont'd)

7. Retail Access Capacity Program (Cont'd)

k) Term of Release

Releases of capacity pursuant to this Retail Access Capacity Program shall be made in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Distribution Provider's GTOP manual.

l) Pipeline and Regulatory Requirements

Distribution Customers to whom capacity is to be, or has been, released pursuant to this Retail Access Capacity Program shall cooperate with the Distribution Provider, meet all applicable requirements of the respective pipelines and governmental entities having jurisdiction over the relevant assets, and make all required payments to the respective pipelines.

D. Service Classification No. 10 - General Service - Distribution Service to Electric Generation

1. Applicable to Use of Service For

Any Direct Customer service point, or Distribution Customer serving a Retail Customer service point where such service point is an electric generating facility, in the entire gas control area, with service limited to service points which meet the Eligibility Criteria listed in D.2, below.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Any new Direct Customer service point or new Retail Customer service point which meets the requirements stated below shall be eligible to receive service in accordance with the rates, charges and provisions set forth under this Service Classification:

- a) The Direct Customer or Retail Customer must operate an electric generating facility having a rated capacity of not less than 50 megawatts.
- b) The Direct Customer's or Retail Customer's generating facility must have the ability to switch to an alternate fuel when notified to do so by the Distribution Provider.
