B. Service Classification No. 4 - General Service - Economic Development (Cont'd)

8. Terms of Payment

All bills are rendered at the rates stated above, in accordance with Rule 5.D(1). If a negotiated Service Agreement is in effect, the late payment charge will be stated in the Agreement but shall not exceed the rate stated in Rule 5.D(2).

9. Other Terms and Conditions

Service under this Service Classification will be provided in accordance with all other terms and conditions described in Service Classification No. 3 - Large General Service, except as specifically noted above.

C. Service Classification No. 5 - Small General Service

1. Applicable to Use of Service for:

All purposes in the entire territory by Distribution Customers serving any Retail Customer whose annual use at the given service point is greater than 3500 dekatherms, or a group of Retail Customers, regardless of the individual Retail Customers' annual use, whose total annual use is greater than 5000 dekatherms.

2. Balancing Service:

All service points served under this service classification will be required to be balanced using the Small Volume Customer Balancing Service, as specified in Schedule B of this tariff.

3. Distribution Rate Adjustment:

The distribution rates set forth in Appendix A for this service classification shall be subject to a distribution rate adjustment per therm of gas distributed. The total Distribution Rate Adjustment for this service classification will be made up of the following components:

- i) The Interdepartmental Sales Credit; and
- ii) The FERC Order 636 Transition Cost Surcharge; and
- iii) Other Pipeline Surcharges/Credits; and
- iv) The PSC Transition Cost Surcharge; and
- v) The Research and Development Surcharge.
