SCHEDULE B

STREET LIGHTING SERVICE

AVAILABLE:

In all of the control area served by the Distribution Provider.

APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Any Distribution Customer supplying service to a Distribution Customer's or Retail Customer's street lighting or traffic signal facilities, for the lighting of public streets, roads, alleys, ways and highways, and the outdoor lighting of public parks and playgrounds, and of public school district property. To receive service under Schedule B, the Distribution Customer must abide by all applicable Distribution Provider Tariff provisions, the Distribution Operating Agreement, the provisions of the NYISO's Transmission Tariffs, and all other applicable laws, rules and provisions.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Distribution Service of continuous, unmetered, alternating 60-cycle current from a distribution point of receipt to a distribution point of delivery. The Distribution Service shall be provided in a voltage and phase available and appropriate for the Distribution Customer's Retail Customers' requirement, at the Distribution Provider's option.

MONTHLY RATE FOR DISTRIBUTION SERVICE:

The Distribution Customer will be billed the applicable charges associated with each of its Retail Customer's service points. Each service point is assigned a Service Classification based on the Characteristics of service at each service point, defined in Special Provisions, below.

For each service point, the monthly rate shall include the service point distribution charges set forth in Appendix B, and all applicable taxes.

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES:

The rates and charges under this Schedule, including any adjustments and pole attachment charges, are increased by the applicable effective percentage shown in Rule 5.E for service supplied within the municipality where the Retail Customer is taking service.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are rendered at the rates stated in the applicable appendix. Refer to Rule 5.D for further information regarding payment terms.

TERM:

Service to the Distribution Customer may be voluntarily discontinued upon sixty days' written notice to the Distribution Provider or in agreement with terms in the Distribution Operating Agreement

SYSTEM BENEFITS CHARGE:

Rates and charges under this Service Classification are increased by the applicable system benefits charge, as mandated by Public Service Commission Order, shown in the System Benefits Charge Statement.

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
