1. DEFINITIONS AND ABBREVIATIONS (Cont'd)

Distribution Point(s) of Receipt: Point(s) at which the Distribution Provider receives gas on the Transmission and/or Distribution System from other sources.

Distribution Provider: A company that maintains and operates a gas Distribution System for the delivery of gas. Under this Tariff, the Distribution Provider is Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation.

Distribution Service: The act of distributing gas from a point(s) of receipt to a point(s) of delivery on the Distribution System.

Distribution System: The facilities owned, controlled or operated by the Distribution Provider that are used to provide gas Distribution Service under this Tariff.

Emergency Service Call: A request for service to be rendered by the Distribution Provider involving a condition of gas service or equipment that affects or may affect the safety, health or welfare of an individual, or that may threaten to damage property.

Energy Services Company (ESCO): See "Distribution Customer".

Energy Supplier: See "Distribution Customer".

Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC): An agency within the United States Department of Energy that, among other things, regulates the wholesale transmission and sales of electricity in interstate commerce, regulates the transmission and sale for resale of natural gas in interstate commerce, and has jurisdiction over hydroelectric licensing.

Gas Marketer: A Distribution Customer serving gas retail customer service points.

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
