Any questions concerning service classifications may be discussed with an RG&E customer service representative. If the information provided on this application is inaccurate or incomplete, you may be subject to backbilling on the correct service classification or precluded from receiving a refund for any overcharges. Should there be any change in your usage or equipment at a future time, you must notify RG&E to assure that you are being billed under the proper service classification. Additional forms may be needed for some service classifications or if new facilities must be constructed.
