F. ASSIGNMENT OF DISTRIBUTION CUSTOMER CONTRACTS (Cont'd)

- (5) If a Distribution Customer does not give the required notices to its Retail Customers, the Distribution Provider and the Commission in accordance with the above requirements prior to transferring Retail Customers, the Distribution Customer may be determined ineligible by the New York State Public Service commission to sell electricity to Retail Customer in New York State and/or may be assessed a monetary penalty by the New York Sate PSC.
- (6) The assignment document(s) (copies of which shall be provided to the Distribution Provider and the Commission) shall indicate which party will be responsible for payment or reimbursement of any and all sums owed under the Tariff or under any tariffs on file with the FERC, and service agreements relating thereto, or under any agreements between the Distribution Customer and the Distribution Provider and between the Distribution Customer and its Retail Customers.
- (7) If a more expeditious transfer process is needed in a specific situation, the Distribution Customer may request such expeditious treatment upon a showing of need to the PSC or its designee, who shall have authority to grant such a request. The Distribution Provider shall have standing in any such process.

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
