D. <u>OPERATION OF THE TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM</u>

(1) Curtailments of Scheduled Deliveries or Load Shedding

Curtailments of scheduled deliveries or load shedding in response to system-wide or local abnormal or emergency events will be on a non-discriminatory basis without regard to which Distribution Customer serves the affected Retail Customer. The Distribution Provider will not impose penalties upon Distribution Customers for differences between the scheduled energy deliveries and Retail Customer load resulting from that response. However, should the Distribution Provider be penalized or compensated by providers of transmission services for the difference between scheduled energy deliveries and actual system load due to this response, this compensation or penalty shall be passed on to the Distribution Customers through the settlement process.
