(d) ERO to BRO:

A Competitive Supplier Price (ERO) customer, whose supplier dropped the customer from Retail Access prior to January 1, 2005, but whose ending (scheduled or Special) Meter Reading date (effective date) will not occur until after January 1, 2005, and such customer has notified NYSEG of their NYSEG Fixed Price (BRO) option selection by Dec. 30, 2004, will be billed at the Competitive Supplier Price (ERO) from January 1, 2005 until the customer's first meter reading date. After that meter read, usage will be billed at the NYSEG Fixed Price (BRO),

(e) ERO to VRO:

A Competitive Supplier Price (ERO) customer, whose supplier dropped the customer from Retail Access prior to January 1, 2005, but whose ending (scheduled or Special) Meter Reading date (effective date) will not occur until after January 1, 2005, and such customer has not notified NYSEG of a NYSEG Fixed Price (BRO) option selection by Dec. 30, 2004, will be billed at the Competitive Supplier Price (ERO) from January 1, 2005 until the customer's first meter reading date. After that meter read, usage will be billed at the NYSEG Variable Price (VRO),

(f) BRO w/RAC to VRO:

A NYSEG Fixed Price with Supply Credit (BRO w/RAC) customer, whose supplier dropped the customer from Retail Access prior to January 1, 2005, but whose ending (scheduled or Special) Meter Reading date (effective date) will not occur until after January 1, 2005, and such customer has notified NYSEG of a NYSEG Variable Price (VRO) option selection by Dec. 30, 2004, will be billed at the NYSEG Fixed Price with Supply Credit (BRO w/RAC) from January 1, 2005 until the customer's first meter reading date. After that meter read, usage will be billed at the NYSEG Variable Price (VRO),

(g) BRO w/RAC to BRO:

A NYSEG Fixed Price with Supply Credit (BRO w/RAC) customer, whose supplier dropped the customer from Retail Access prior to January 1, 2005, but whose ending (scheduled or Special) Meter Reading date (effective date) will not occur until after January 1, 2005, will be billed at the NYSEG Fixed Price with Supply Credit (BRO w/RAC) from January 1, 2005 until the customer's first meter reading date. After that meter read, usage will be billed at the NYSEG Fixed Price (BRO),
