B. Local Calling Area

Stations bearing the designations of central offices within the exchanges of Millbrooke, Amenia, Clinton Corners, Clintondale, Dover Plains, Esopus, Highland, Hopewell Junction (Sylvan Lake Telephone Company, Inc.), Hyde Park, Kingston, Marlboro, Milton, North Clove, Pawling, Pleasant Valley, Poughkeepsie, Rhinebeck (Red Hook Telephone Company), Rosendale, Staatsburg (Red Hook Telephone Company), Stanfordville, Wappingers Falls and Wingdale.

C. Charges for Local Calls from Flat Rate and Message Rate Telephones

1. Flat Rate Service

Flat Rate Service includes unlimited calling privilege to points listed in Paragraph B. preceding, except that such calls placed on a person-to-person basis or an operator-handled station-to-station basis are charged for under the rate band schedule as shown in Paragraph 2. following.
