SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 2 (Cont'd)

GENERAL SERVICE - SMALL USE

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

1. Change of Service Classification

The Company will install a demand measuring device and provide service under Service Classification No. 7 - General Service - 12 kilowatts Minimum:

- a. Whenever it is determined that the customer is using, or might use, more than 12 kilowatts of billing demand, or
- b. Whenever the customer's consumption during the preceding 12 months has exceeded 3,000 kilowatthours in each of four consecutive monthly billing periods, or 6,000 kilowatthours in two bi-monthly billing periods.

2. Economic Development Zone Rider

New service under this rider will no longer be available to customers whose zone certificate includes an initial date of eligibility after January 1, 2005.

Service taken under this Service Classification may be eligible for the rates and charges under the Economic Development Zone Rider. Any customer who meets the qualifications set forth under General Information Section 4.L.2 shall pay for service at the following rate:

3. Incremental Manufacturing Load Rider

New service under this rider will no longer be available after June 30, 2002.

Service taken under this Service Classification may be eligible for the rates and charges under the Incremental Manufacturing Load Rider. Any customer who meets the qualifications set forth under Rule 4.L.3 of this tariff shall pay for service for its eligible load at the following rate:
