RIDER No. 1
Economic Development

- d. for the fourth year after the date of initiation of service, a delivery charge of \$0.008 per kWh,
- e. for the fifth year after the date of initiation of service, a delivery charge of \$0.01 per kWh,
- f. after five years from the date of initiation of service by the Customer under this Rider, the customer rate will revert to a S.C. No. 4 service, or other rate class available at that time.

(3) A Power Supply Charge defined as follows:

- 1. Customers qualifying for this rate will receive demand and energy as follows:
 - a. Under the Municipal and Rural Cooperative Economic Development Program Customers will receive up to one-half of incremental billing demand and energy from NYPA. The balance of the monthly billing demand and energy will be supplied by the MED.
 - b. For all other NYPA programs, the incremental billing demand and energy received from NYPA will vary depending on the NYPA program utilized. The balance of the monthly billing demand and energy will be supplied by the MED.
- 2. The cost of demand and energy for the power supply will be adjusted, if necessary, to include the cost of transmission and related ancillary services that are required to deliver power to retail electric customers that are served in New York, including, but not limited to, costs imposed by the New York Independent System Operator, or subsequent organization with similar functions. Demand and energy provided to serve the customer will be adjusted for losses from the point of purchase by the MED, or from some other point where losses are charged, to the point of sale to the customer.
