INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES:

The rates and charges under this Service Classification, including any system benefits charge, adjustments and minimum charge, are increased by the applicable effective aggregate percentage shown in Rule 4.J for service supplied within the municipality where the customer is taking service.

MINIMUM DELIVERY DEMAND CHARGE:

The minimum monthly delivery demand charge is \$3.31 (secondary), \$3.43 (sub transmission-secondary), \$3.43 (primary), \$2.31 (subtransmission-Industrial), \$2.30 (subtransmission-commercial) or \$2.14 (transmission) per kilowatt of service capacity contracted for.
