## 5.17 CHATLINE SERVICES

## 5.17.1 Provision of Chatline-type Services

- A. Pursuant to the Commission's February 4, 1999 Order in Case Nos. 98-C-1273 and 98-C-1479, the Company will designate a specific NXX code as a blockable content related services code for any chatline-type services it offers. Access to such code will be limited to customers within the applicable LATA.
- B. Any customer intending to use the Company's service to operate a chatline-type service, or to allow its Company service to be used by an operator of such a service, shall first so notify the Company in writing, and shall request a blockable telephone number from the Company for such service. No customer may use any Company service to operate a chatline-type service, or to allow its Company service to be so used by any third party, unless the service is on a blockable code.
- C. The Company will terminate service, in accordance with the procedures set forth in this tariff, to information providers or other entities that violate its tariff terms and conditions relating to the blocking of content-type services.
- D. The Company will not connect any new chatlines to its network until certain carrier and customer notification periods set forth in Case Nos. 98-C-1273 and 98-C-1479 have expired.

## 5.18 REVENUE SHARING

Chatline Providers and other high usage subscribers may be eligible for revenue sharing payments based on percentages of usage for local terminating access and/or interstate access paid to the Company by purchasers of Company's access services. To be eligible for revenue sharing, the Subscriber must be collocated in a Company Switch Site or own a PRI T1 to Subscriber's premises. These payments will be based solely on monthly usage minimums in minutes as follows:
