## CHARGES

## A. RECONNECTION CHARGE

When service has been discontinued and the same Customer applies for reconnection of service at the same location within four (4) months, a reconnection charge will be made in the amounts as follows:
$\$ 65.00$ between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on working days, Monday through Friday.
\$205.00 after 3:30 p.m. on working days, Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday.
\$260.00 all day Sunday and Holidays.
The reconnection charge shall he payable before service will be established.

## B. INSUFFICIENT CHECK CHARGE

Any checks received in payment for electric service which are returned to the Utility for insufficient funds or are otherwise dishonored by the bank shall bear a nonrecurring charge for each check that has to be processed by the Utility. If two checks have been returned by the bank, the Customer who issued the dishonored checks may be required by the Utility to render future payments by cash, money order, certified or cashier's check. Post-dated checks shall be returned to the Customer as invalid for the transaction. Only United States currency shall be accepted for payment of accounts due the Utility.

## C. METER TESTING

The Customer may request, and the Utility shall supply a test of the metering equipment. The cost of the first test shall be borne by the Utility. Any subsequent test of the metering equipment, requested by the Customer within four (4) years of a previous test, shall be performed at the expense of the Customer. When a test shows the meter to be accurate within two percent (2\%), slow or fast, or in excess of two percent (2\%) slow, no adjustment will be made in a consumer's bill. When such test shows the meter to be in excess of two percent (2\%) fast, an adjustment will be made in the consumer's bill over a period not to exceed thirty (30) days prior to the date of the test.
