The net amount resulting from this calculation will be divided by the total projected sales to Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2, 3 and 21 for the period beginning with the calendar month in question and ending at the end of the then current Gas Cost Year, to determine the units (per therm) monthly overcollection or undercollection balance.

If the resulting overcollection or undercollection factor is greater than \$0.02 per therm, then the Monthly Cost of Gas Imbalance Surcharge or Refund factor for the calendar month in question shall be limited to \$0.02 per therm; if the resulting overcollection or undercollection factor is less than or equal to \$0.02 per therm, no surcharge or refund factor will be reflected for the calendar month in question. The Company shall be permitted to revise the \$0.02 per therm tolerance band during the year if it determines that such an adjustment, upward or downward, is necessary to minimize the projected overcollection at the end of the period; provided, however, that the resultant refund will not exceed \$0.05 per therm.
