X. Additional Terms and Conditions Applicable to Contracted Sales and Transportation Services: (Cont'd)

D. Basis of Measurement:

All natural gas delivered pursuant to contract shall be measured and computed by company in accordance with the specifications contained in Gas Committee Report No. 3 of the American Gas Association published in April 1955. The measurement unit shall be 1,000 cubic feet (1 Mcf) of gas at a pressure of 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at a temperature of 60 degrees Fahrenheit.

E. Delivery Pressure:

Company shall deliver gas at the outlet of the metering and/or regulating equipment at a pressure to be agreed upon but not less than four inches of water column.

F. Quality:

The gas delivered to company's customers shall be of a quality which shall be in accord with the gas standards promulgated by the Public Service Commission of the State of New York in its General Regulations for Gas Corporations. Gas received or to be received by company from customer, or an Agent on behalf of a group of customers, shall be in accord with the said gas standards.

G. Overrun Gas:

1. Customers served under Service Classification Nos. 3, 4, and 5 have contracted for the maximum volume of gas they require to be delivered to them ("Contract Volume") (see definition in 2.XI.D.). Customers served under Service Classification Nos. 4 and 5 may on any day be ordered to discontinue or to restrict to a certain volume (the "Restricted Level") consumption under such classification. Upon request of customer, deliveries in excess of the Contract Volume or in excess of the Restricted Level may be continued at such level as company in its sole discretion may authorize (Authorized Daily Volume). Such continuation of service shall constitute authorized overrun and the volume so authorized shall be the Authorized Quantity. The distribution delivery rate per therm of Authorized Quantity shall be the Distribution Delivery rate per therm specified in Service Classification No. 2 for "Next 4,930 therms", plus the Gas Imbalance Charge.
