The Company shall charge the following charges to a Marketer that requests suspension of service to a residential Customer or a two-family dwelling receiving Consolidated Bills or to a multiple dwelling pursuant to the Home Energy Fair Practices Act (Public Service Law, Article 2) ("HEFPA"):

Suspension Visit to the Premises:	\$29.00	each time the Company sends an employee to the Customer's premises to suspend gas and/or electric service, provided, however, that this charge will be \$37.50 if both gas and electric services are disconnected at the meter during the visit.
Visit to End Suspension:	\$66.00	each time for a residential non-heating Customer if the Company sends an employee to the Customer's premises to end the suspension of gas service, provided, however, this charge will be reduced to \$45.00 if the Company is unable to gain access to the meter.
	\$248.00	each time for a residential heating Customer if the Company sends an employee to the Customer's premises to end the suspension of gas service, provided, however, this charge will be reduced to \$29.00 if the Company is unable to gain access to the meter.
