**RATES (Per Month)**

**Delivery Rates:** There are up to four rate components of the delivery rate portion of this Standby Service: Customer Charge, Contract Demand Charge, As-Used Demand Charge, and Reactive Charge, as applicable. The delivery rates include an allocation of the Transition Charge to the Customer Charge, Contract Demand Charge, and As-Used Demand Charge. The delivery rates will be revised to reflect changes to the Transition Charge each April 1 and October 1, as well as on January 1, 2005, the beginning of the second commodity period, according to the Commission's Order Adopting Provisions of the Joint Proposal with Modifications, Cases 01-E-0359 and 01-M-0404, issued February 27, 2002 (the "Electric Rate Plan").
