 - (k) Once EDIC for Consolidated Billing and Payment Processing is operational, the Company will provide mechanisms that will allow customers to choose, through their ESCO, a Consolidated Billing and Payment Processing option, consistent with Section 16.J of this Schedule.
 - 9. Scheduling, Balancing and Settlement:
 - (a) The following applies to scheduling, balancing and settlement with the NYISO:
 - i. ESCOs/DCs will schedule Electric Power Supply directly with the NYISO.
 - ii. NYSEG will calculate customer load excluding NYSEG System Losses, by hour, by subzone, and combine accounts by ESCO/DC.
 - iii. NYSEG will communicate the load calculations to the NYISO, in accordance with the NYISO's Billing Schedule for true-ups.
 - iv. The NYISO will balance the load calculations with the ESCO/DC schedules, price the imbalance, and invoice or credit the ESCO/DC for the cost of the imbalance.
 - v. The NYISO will apply any additional applicable charges, as appropriate.

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
