NYSEG will calculate the amount of the ESCO's/DC's NYISO Ancillary Services bill related to Schedule 1 (as detailed in Section 16.E.8 (j) iiiabove) and Schedule 2, for which the Company will provide reimbursement. By the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) business day of the month, NYSEG will provide each ESCO's/DC's hourly load, without losses and shaped to the profile by subzone, to the NYISO. NYSEG will calculate the reimbursement amounts for each ESCO/DC consistent with the NYISO billing procedures.
        - v. For Schedule 3, Schedule 5, and Schedule 6 NYISO Ancillary Services, NYSEG will calculate the reimbursement amounts for each ESCO/DC consistent with the NYISO billing procedures.
