III. APPLICATION AND DENIAL (cont'd.)

A. Extension of Service (cont'd.)

- 4. The Corporation will provide service to any accepted applicant whose application for service was previously denied, unless prevented by those circumstances listed in paragraph 1 of this subdivision:
 - (4a) as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than two business days after the requirements of paragraph 3 of this subdivision are met or such later time as may be specified by the applicant; or
 - (4b) within 24 hours, if required by the Commission or its designee.
- 5. A residential customer moving within the service territory of the Corporation and requesting service within 60 calendar days of the customer's prior account is eligible to receive service at the new location, and such service will be considered a continuation of services in all respects, with any existing payment agreement honored; provided, however, that such customer's prior service had not been terminated for non-payment at the time of the request.
- 6. The Corporation will supply the customer with service when the Commission or its authorized designee directs the provision of service.
- 7. The Corporation may require a residential applicant to complete a written application for service only if:
 - (7a) service to the preceding customer at the premises to be served was terminated for nonpayment within the prior 12 months or the current account is subject to a final notice of termination;
 - (7b) there is evidence that service has been supplied through tampered equipment;
 - (7c) the meter has recorded usage during a period within the previous 12 months when there was no customer; or
 - (7d) the application is made by a third party on behalf of party who would receive service.
- 8. If a written application is not required as a prerequisite to providing residential service, an oral application for service will be considered complete when the applicant provides his or her name, address, and, if the applicant has a prior account, either the address or account number, and answers questions relevant to identifying the applicant's use of water on the premises, including whether the service will be used primarily for residential purposes.
