III. APPLICATION AND DENIAL

A. Extension of Service

- 1. The corporation will provide service to any residential applicant who meets the requirements of Section 3 of this subdivision as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than five business days after receipt of an accepted oral or written application for service; or such later time as may be specified by the applicant, except:
 - (1a) where prevented by labor strikes or other work stoppages;
 - (1b) where precluded by consideration of public safety;
 - (1c) where precluded by physical impediments including:
 - (1c.1) adverse weather conditions;
 - (1c.2) inability to gain access to premises; or
 - (1c.3) incomplete construction of necessary facilities by the applicant or inspection and certification of such facilities by the appropriate authorities; or
 - (1c.4) incomplete construction of necessary facilities by the Corporation.
- 2. The Corporation will make reasonable efforts to eliminate or correct conditions over which it has control that prevent extensions of service and will attempt to complete construction of any necessary facilities with due diligence.
- 3. As a prerequisite to accepting a party as a residential customer and providing service, the Corporation may require the party to:
 - (3a) make full payments or enter into a payment agreement for all amounts due and payable which are not either the subject of a pending billing dispute or covered by an existing payment agreement, including:
 - (3a.1) residential service provided and billed to prior accounts in the applicant's name or for which the applicant is legally responsible;
 - (3a.2) other billed tariff fees, charges or penalties,
 - (3a.3) a deposit, if requested by the corporation, as long as such deposit is in accordance with 16 NYCRR 14.11.
 - (3b) fulfill any applicable requirements of Parts 501 and 502 of Title 16 NYCRR regarding main extensions and service pipes;
 - (3c) comply with the Corporation's tariff, and any applicable state, city or local laws, ordinances or regulations.
