C. Charges for Additional Facilities: (Cont'd)

- (h) Upon mutual agreement of both Company and applicant, an applicant may provide a guarantee of performance, in lieu of the contribution required in Section 6.C.(1)(g) of this Schedule.
- (2) If, in order to provide service to an applicant, the Company must install service lines, service connections and appurtenant facilities in addition to those required to be provided without charge under Section 6.B. of this Schedule, the Company may impose a charge for material and installation costs under the following provisions:
 - (a) Customers whose service diameter does not exceed 2 inches, will be charged \$4.50 per foot for the incremental length of service installed. This charge will be reviewed annually, and any changes will be filed with the PSC by February 1. The revised charge will be based on the weighted average cost per foot of incremental services installed during the previous year, twelve months ended September 30. If the estimated cost of installation is greater than two (2) times the applicable flat fee or less than or equal to one-half (1/2) the applicable flat fee, the customer shall be charged for the actual incremental material and installation costs as set forth in Section 35 of this Schedule.
 - (b) Customers whose service diameter exceeds 2 inches shall be charged material and installation costs as set forth in Section 35 of this Schedule.
 - (c) Customers may install, at their own expense, service lines or trench (beyond that required to be provided by the Company without charge) in accordance with such rules and regulations for the construction thereof as may be filed in the schedules of the Company. Before service is supplied to any location, all piping and equipment must be inspected and approved by the inspector of the Company.
