- B. Reliability Insurance Commodity Quantity (RICQ)
 - <u>Daily Metered Transportation</u> The quantity of gas delivered to the Marketer's/Pool Operator's Customers less the quantity of gas scheduled and delivered to the Company pursuant to Section 4.C. of this Schedule, not to exceed the RIDQ of the Pool, on a Day when Marketer's/Pool Operator's deliveries to the Company on a secondary basis are restricted by the applicable Upstream Pipeline, or it has demonstrated that it is unable to make deliveries to the Company because its recallable capacity has been recalled.
 - 2. Non-Daily Metered Transportation The Marketer's Daily Aggregated Volume (DAV), less the quantity of gas scheduled by the Upstream Pipeline for that Day, not to exceed the RIDQ of the Aggregation Pool, on a Day when Marketer's/Aggregation Pool Operators deliveries to the Company on a secondary basis are restricted by the applicable Upstream Pipeline, or it has demonstrated that it is unable to make deliveries to the Company because its recallable capacity has been recalled.

PRICE:

- A. <u>Reliability Insurance Demand Charge</u> Equal to the Company's weighted average demand cost of gas less the applicable capacity release credits per therm for the current month.
- B. <u>Reliability Insurance Commodity Charge</u> Equal to the Company's Maximum Daily Gas Index as defined in PSC No. 88, or superseding issues thereof, plus fuel and commodity costs as set forth in each applicable pipeline's FERC tariff, to the citygate for each therm.
