3. Special Services at Stipulated Rates

(a) Special Request for Billing and Credit Information

Upon request, the Company will furnish up to 24 months of historical usage and billing information to a Customer or the Customer's authorized Marketer free of charge within five business days of receipt of such request if and to the extent such information is available electronically. The Company will charge \$15.00 per account per year of information requested when usage and billing information is required beyond that provided at no charge. The type of historical usage and billing information available is further explained in Con Edison's Operating Procedures.

Upon request, the Company will furnish up to 12 months of credit information to a Customer or the Customer's authorized Marketer free of charge within five business days of receipt of such request. Credit information that will be provided will state whether or not the Customer had a late payment record and/or had service terminated for non-payment during the preceding twelve month period. For information beyond the most recent 12 months, the Company will charge \$15.00 per account per year of information requested.

The Company will not disclose historical usage and billing information to a Marketer if the Customer has given advance written notification to the Company that such information should not be disclosed. The information may thereafter be disclosed to a Marketer only with the Customer's written authorization.

The Company will not disclose credit information to a Marketer unless the Customer has given the Marketer written authorization to receive such information.
