(POWER RATE)

TRANSFORMER OWNERSHIP CREDIT:

When the Customer elects to install, own and maintain the transformers and associated equipment required to take service at primary voltage, thereby saving the Village the cost of such equipment, a credit of thirty cents (\$0.30) per kilowatt of billing demand for such month shall be allowed against the amount determined under the preceding provisions.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge is the Demand Charge computed under RATE, the Billing Demand being determined in accordance with the provisions included under Determination of Billing Demand.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING-DEMAND:

A. The Demand shall be the maximum thirty (30) minute integrated kilowatt demand. For billing purposes the Billing Demand shall be the greatest of the following:

1. The maximum demand occurring during the month for which charge is made.
2. Seventy Five (75) percent of the highest demand occurring during any of the preceding eleven (11) months.
3. During the initial term, the demand contracted for.
4. Twenty (20) kilowatts.
