SPECIAL PROVISIONS: (continued)

Energy for additional lamps will be supplied upon customer's written request. Such written requests will be appended to customer's Form "P" Contract, "Application for Service". Written notification will also be required when maps are to be removed. A revised Schedule "W" will be required. If attachment to wood poles is desired, customer will also be required to enter into an attachment agreement which states the terms and conditions under which attachments may be made.

B. Customer shall inquire as to the characteristics of the service to be supplied prior to the purchase of electrical equipment. Customer shall also furnish a map of its street lighting system which indicates the location and the nominal wattage rating of the lamps to be installed and the location and type of underground construction in triplicate with its application for service. Additional maps shall be provided each time the street lighting system is revised.

C. Customer shall install only high power factor regulated ballasts. A certification that high power factor regulated ballasts are to be installed by a responsible official representing the applicant will be required. Company will perform "spot" field inspections to insure compliance.

D. Company is not responsible, by inspection, if any, or non-rejection, nor in any other way give warranty, expressed or implied, for the adequacy, safety or other characteristics of any structures, equipment, wires or luminaires, owned, installed or maintained by customer or leased by customer from third parties.

E. Company will not be liable for any injury, casualty or damage resulting in any way from the supply or use of electricity in customer's facilities or the rental use of Company facilities.

F. Customer's equipment and wiring shall be approved by a competent inspection agency. The customer's attachments and connections on Company's poles and facilities shall be in accordance with the requirements and specifications of the National Electric Safety Code, Company specifications, and specifications of other joint users and prior licensees. The Company shall approve the unit installation and may restrict the type of equipment and support bracket to be installed on existing wood poles. Connection to Company's system shall be made only by Company's personnel or its designee.
