E. Control mechanisms of the electromagnetic type in excess of 25 watts will be considered one signal face.

F. Lamps exceeding 69 watts/lens will be considered one signal-face for the first 69 watts and one additional signal-face for each major fraction thereof.

G. The Company will compute the number of signal faces on Walk/Don't Walk pedestrian control devices. The basis for the calculation will be 69 watts.

H. The Company may conduct audit(s) of the customer's traffic signal system or any portion thereof on a periodic basis, at the Company's discretion.

RATE:

A. <u>Signal Face Charge</u> \$3.54 per signal-face per month.

## B. <u>Cost of Fuel Adjustment</u>

The energy use by the equipment installed shall be subject to a fuel adjustment per kilowatthour, billed hereunder when changes from the base cost of fuel occur. The fuel adjustment shall be the fuel adjustment as calculated monthly in accordance with Rule 29 of the General Electric Tariff. The fuel cost adjustment will be based on 50 kilowatthours per month per signal face.

## C. <u>Increase in Rates and Charges</u>
