SPECIAL PROVISIONS: (continued)

K. In the event of changes or revisions of this service classification, customer shall take and pay for service in accordance with the provisions of the revised or superseding service classification. Charges to Customers shall be prorated between the superseding and the superseded rate on the basis of the actual number of days in the billing period, with the superseding charges applying to the days of service taken on or after the effective date of such change.

L. Service hereunder shall be deemed subject to the provisions of Section 103-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York as from time to time amended.

M. Service hereunder will be supplied by Company subject to the provisions of orders, amendments and interpretations thereof of any governmental body having authority or jurisdiction over such service, notwithstanding anything of the contrary in the rules and regulations, and the terms and conditions of service as set forth herein.

N. Overhead street lighting facilities will not be served in areas where Company has an existing underground distribution system.

O. Customer's equipment shall be disconnected by Company and physically removed from Company's poles by customer within 15 days subsequent to the termination of an agreement.

P. Customer owned equipment shall be identified by the installation of a red plastic band around the support immediately behind the luminaire. Each unit shall be field identified in accordance with the latest EEI-NEMA Standards for Field Identification of High Intensity Discharge Lamps and Luminaires (NEMA Pub. No. OD150-1974 and subsequent revisions).

Q. The customer's service shall include an appropriate in-line disconnecting device equipped with over-current protection. The location of this equipment shall be approved by Company prior to installation.

R. Tree trimming required for light distribution on the highway, street and/or sidewalk surfaces and/or for the protection of customer's street lighting equipment is the responsibility of the customer.
