Power for Jobs customers will be subject to a monthly adjustment per Kw to reflect variances between estimated and actual charges for PASNY capacity, including competitively bid power and transmission of PASNY power to the Company's system, inclusive of losses and any minimum bill obligation and any applicable taxes incurred by the Company and not otherwise reflected in the foregoing charges.

In addition to the charges above, Central Hudson will bill a customer charge of \$25.00 per month, exclusive of increase in rates and charges to cover incremental billing and administrative costs associated with providing service to a Power for Jobs customer.

Minimum Charge

The monthly demand shall be the highest 15 minute integrated kilowatt demand established during the month for which the bill is rendered, but not less than 500 kilowatts. The minimum charge per month shall be the sum of the customer charges described above plus the demand charges described above applied to the monthly demand.

Term of Service

The term of service for each customer is to be established by the New York State economic development power allocation board not to exceed three years, provided however that if the board directs the partial or complete withdrawal of the Customer's allocation during the term, the term or amount of service under this special provision will be adjusted accordingly.

Determination of Energy and Demand Billing

In the event that NYPA is unable to deliver in any billing period any portion or all of the Power for Jobs power to the Company as contracted for under the "Power for Jobs Purchase and Resale Agreement" between PASNY and the Company, each customer shall have his contract lowered by the amount of reduced deliveries allocated on a pro rata basis across all Power for Jobs allocations. All such energy not delivered and subsequently replaced with load supplied by the Company shall be billed according to the other applicable rates under this Service Classification.
